

## **WAGON MASTER**

The objective of the Alfa South Loafers RV Club is to provide a campout for its members where good fellowship, fun, and just good old relaxation is King. However, to accomplish this objective, we cannot depend on just a few club members to carry the load; it takes all of us. As a member of the club, you will be asked to help reach our objective by being a wagon master for a campout.

### **DUTIES**

1. Select and secure reservation for a site at least 6 months in advance of the club's outing. Advance payment for reservation deposit will be reimbursed you from the club treasury; up to \$300.00.
2. Check with park ranger to be sure there is ample room to accommodate rigs up to 13' high and 40' long, and that slide outs are acceptable.
3. Give all information on the place selected, directions, and amount per rig, along with a schedule of any planned events such as games, auctions, parties, etc. to the Secretary so the registration forms can be made up. The Secretary will mail out the registration forms and would appreciate having this information at the club meeting prior to your campout. The registration form will provide a box identifying new members.
4. Be on site, if possible, to direct rigs to assigned spaces. In your absence, your assistant wagon master will take charge.
5. Maintain coffee supplies as needed. Coffee, creamer, sweeteners, cups, and stirrers will be reimbursed from the treasury.
6. Arrange and select time for meals, refreshments, and any other special activities that are planned. Club members should help set up tables. If a clubhouse is to be used, it should be reserved 1 hour before meals to allow time to make coffee, set up tables, etc.
7. Collect all fees not paid in advance, and pay the park manager.
8. Please read your park contract and **KNOW WHAT YOU SIGN!!!!**
