

ALFA SOUTH LOAFERS BY-LAWS

- ARTICLE I** This Chapter shall be named the South Loafers Chapter
- ARTICLE II** The purpose of the South Loafers Chapter shall be the promotion of good fellowship, enjoyment of and companionship among Alfa owners at regularly scheduled or specially planned gatherings of South Loafer members.
- ARTICLE III** Membership:
1. Regular
 2. Honorary
- Section 1 An applicant for regular membership must be the owner of an Alfa RV.
- Section 2 Dues shall be \$15.00 per RV per year. \$3.00 per RV per year shall be transferred to the Sunshine fund. Dues are due and payable in January of each year. The dues of a new member starting after September 1st shall be good through the following dues year.
- If for any reason a member is dropped from the Chapter, there will be no refund of dues.
- Section 3 In the event of withdrawals for the purpose of forming a new Chapter, this Chapter may provide a starting fund for the new Chapter. This starting fund shall be determined as follows:
- A. The percentage of members shall be calculated from the total membership at the time of withdrawal.
 - B. The starting fund shall be the calculated percentage times the amount in the Chapter treasury at the time of withdrawal.
- Section 4 A member shall be dropped from the Chapter for the following reasons:
- A. Non-payment of dues after 60 days delinquency.
 - B. Causing a disturbance or not complying with park rules, if such actions recur after a warning from the wagon master.
 - C. Ceasing to be an owner of an Alfa RV. The membership may continue to the end of the dues year.
- Section 5 Honorary Membership
- A. Honorary lifetime membership may be conferred by a majority vote of regular members at a properly conducted meeting with at least 20 percent of regular members present.

- B. Honorary members shall enjoy all privileges and responsibilities of regular members, except the right to vote or hold office. They are not required to own an RV.
- C. Honorary members will remain on the roster and receive all mailings, and are not required to pay dues.

ARTICLE IV Officers

Section 1 The Officers shall be:

President, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer, and National Board of Directors representatives and alternates.

Section 2 Duties

A. President

The President shall conduct all meetings of the membership. He/she shall appoint all committees and any special committee deemed necessary for the betterment of the Chapter, or the Sundancers Organization in general.

If a Chapter officer is unable to complete their term, the President may appoint a member to complete that term.

B. Vice President

The Vice President shall act on behalf of the President in the President's absence. If the President is unable to complete his/her term, the Vice President will assume the office of President. The Vice President shall take the office of President the following term.

C. Secretary/Treasurer

Secretary duties include recording the business of the meeting and preparing the official minutes; and is responsible for mailing all correspondence to the membership and interested parties.

Treasurer duties include receiving and disbursing the Chapter funds in accordance with the interest of the Chapter, and furnishing a financial statement at regular meetings.

Copies of the minutes and financial statements shall be retained for a period of 2 years.

D. National Board of Directors Representative

The Directors or alternates shall represent the Chapter at all meetings of the National Board of Directors.

Section 3 Committees

A. Election Committee

In October of each year, the President shall appoint a nominating committee to present a slate of officers for the election to be held at the January campout. Elected officers of the Chapter will be installed at the Chapter meeting of the National Rally. Election of officers shall be by a vote of a simple majority of the members present.

B. Financial Review Committee

Annually, at the National Rally and the change of officers, the President shall appoint a Financial Review Committee of three (3) non-officer members. That committee shall examine the financial records of the club for the preceding year and report its findings to the membership at a chapter meeting.

Section 4 Term of Office

The term of office for all elected officers shall be for 1 year, from National Rally to National Rally with the exception of the National Board of Directors who shall be elected for three National Rallies.

ARTICLE V Activities

Section 1 It is customary to have six (6) campouts per year, including the Alfa Rally. A member who shall be called "wagon master" shall head each campout. Each member shall be willing to volunteer to organize a campout. Campouts are scheduled for the second full weekend in June (so as not to conflict with Father's Day) and the third full weekends of January, March, August, and October. The dates of the annual Alfa Rally are set by the National Board of Directors and will vary. The wagon master shall determine the place of the campout.

Section 2 The dates for any individual campout may be subject to change.

Section 3 Guest RV's will be welcome at one (1) campout per year, providing space is available as determined by the wagon master. Guest RV's may not attend the annual Alfa Rally.

ARTICLE VI Amendments

Section 1 Proposed amendments, additions, and deletions to these By-Laws shall be read at two consecutively called business meetings of the Chapter. A copy of the proposed amendments, additions, or deletions, and a written ballot (one per person) shall be sent to members with the minutes of the second meeting at which the proposed amendments, additions, deletions shall have been read. Approval shall be by a single majority of the ballots received by the Secretary 1 week prior to the next scheduled meeting.

ARTICLE VII Chapter Liability

Section 1 All members attending a South Loafers campout are required to sign the following which will be maintained for 1 year by the incumbent secretary.

The undersigned acknowledges that the Alfa Club facilitates the holding of campouts solely as a service to club members. The Alfa Owners Club neither maintains nor inspects the facilities at which the campouts are held, or provides security services of any kind. Members attend at their own risk, and by signing this document waive any claim against the Alfa Owners Club, and the officers, employees, and agents of, for property damage, theft, or personal injuries of any kind which they or their family members may sustain while at a campout.


Section 2 Guests of members who shall attend a South Loafers campout will be required to sign the following, which will be maintained for 1 year by the incumbent Secretary.

We agree that we will not hold the Alfa Owners Club, nor any officer, employee, or agent of, responsible for personal injury of any kind, which we or any member of our family may suffer during the campout. This agreement applies regardless of the cause of the injury and includes, without limiting it, whether such injury is caused by a condition of the premises, a club member, or any other person. (We make this agreement in consideration of the expenses, which the Alfa Owners Club incurs by holding the campout for our benefit, and recognizes that in signing this paper we may be waiving a legal right to recover damage.)


