## **LAKE CONROE/HOUSTON NORTH KOA PET REGULATIONS**

No attack dogs. German Shepard, Doberman, Pit Bull, Mastiff and Mastiff cross breeds. If you have a doubt about your dog, please call Park for clarification.

Dogs must be on leash at all times. Owners must pickup after their dogs. Dogs can be walked from your camp site to the dog walk areas. There are several areas through out the Park. All are clearly signed. Park does not supply poop bags.

### **SUGGESTIONS**

Coyotes and Bob Cats are in the area. Small dogs and cats are their favorite food. We highly suggest you do not leave them out at night or day without being with them.

Alligators do inhabit Lake Conroe. There is no danger in the park as it is not directly on the lake. Poisonous snakes can be anywhere in Texas, but are not known to be a problem in the area.

## **NASA-LYNDON BANES JOHNSON SPACE CENTER TOUR**

Tour will last approximately eight to ten hours depending on traffic on freeways during bus trip there and back. Actual tour takes about six hours, depending on just how much you want to see. There is quite a bit of walking and stair climbing, elevators are available for those that can't make the stairs. It will be a tiring day.

Betty and I just did the tour and we would do it again. We both highly recommend that you take the tour unless you are physically impaired. Would not recommend it for those on oxygen or with difficulty standing for long periods of time. They offer wheel chair accessibility. You will have to wait in lines for the next show or tour. The Trolley Tour takes the most energy. I would suggest that you do that first to get the hardest part out of the way.

The Tour is worth it just to see the Saturn Five Rocket. It dwarfs the Shuttle take off hardware. The Rocket that is on display was to go to the moon, but the program was cancelled before it was due to launch.

## **OTHER POINTS OF INTEREST**

The Blue Bell Creamery is down the road in Brenham. The tour there is great with free ice cream at the end.

Washington on the Brazos, the birth place of the Republic of Texas, is an easy half day trip and can be done at the same time as the Blue Bell trip.

The George H. W. Bush Library is 60 miles away in College Station.

Houston offers a wide variety of Museums that offer world class exhibits.

There are also wineries, cheese factories, crafts and antiques. Not to mention fishing on Lake Conroe and several great golf courses nearby.

There is a Wal-Mart just across Hwy.105 and lots of good eating places just down the road.

Downtown old Montgomery has several great restaurants and antique shops. Old Downtown Spring is the Crafts Capitol of Texas.

If the Rally can't keep you busy there is plenty else to do.

## **DIRECTIONS TO LAKE CONROE/HOUSTON NORTH KOA**

**FROM I-45 NORTH OUT OF HOUSTON:** Take Exit 87 on to Hwy. 105 West. Turn left or west on to Hwy. 105 West. Proceed west 13 miles. The park will be on the left. There is a traffic light at the entrance.

**FROM I-45 SOUTH OUT OF DALLAS-FT. WORTH:** Take Exit 87 on to Hwy. 105 West. Turn right or west on to Hwy. 105 West. Proceed west 13 miles. The Park will be on the left. There is a traffic light at the entrance.

The ways in from the East or West are too numerous to discuss. So I won't. Just use your Navigator. All do wind up on Hwy. 105. There will always be the traffic light at the Entrance.
